

The 5 Things You Should Know Before Buying PDF Software

Here's a comprehensive list of things you should consider before buying a PDF creation software.

Let's discuss each one of them in more detail.

1 PDF Quality

PDF output quality is probably the first thing you need to consider before investing into PDF software.

You want to make sure that the PDF creation engine is mature and well known in the PDF industry.

One of the best-known PDF creation engines is called Postscript® to PDF. This technology is used by Adobe and by gDoc/Jaws PDF technologies.

In fact, the Jaws PDF development team at Global Graphics have been leading technology innovators in the PostScript® Language field. They've been developing PDF creation tools since the format's inception in 1993.

2 PDF Compatibility

As a PDF user you want to make sure that created PDF files are compatible with other PDF applications, for example Adobe Viewer or PDF viewer offered by other providers.

In order for your PDF files to be readable on other PDF applications you need to make sure that the software you are using to create PDFs conforms to the industry standards. gDoc/Jaws PDF conforms to PDF Specifications and therefore, compatible with other standard PDF applications.

3 PDF Print Quality

If you are in the pre-press industry or if you send PDF files to publishing firms you want to pay attention to the PDF print quality.

The pre-press and print publishing industries use PDF format because it's reliable. However, the problem is that PDF can be used in many other ways, not just for pre-press.

They can include comments and annotations, and they may be made with RGB colors, or perhaps without embedded fonts. When a pre-press provider opens a PDF file with any or all of these conditions it can down the production process.

That's why PDF/X, a subset of the PDF Specification, was designed to eliminate many of the color, font, and trapping variables that lead to printing problems. Jaws PDF software conforms to PDF/X specification that was created to make PDF in the pre-press world reliable and dependable.

4 Cost

The PDF creation marketplace can intimidate your average office worker who is suddenly responsible for creating and maintaining PDF documents.

The cost of PDF writer software ranges anywhere between twenty dollars to several hundred dollars.

There are a variety of software makers competing in the PDF industry. A popular PDF creation software costs from \$299.00 to \$449.00 per user. This can be outside of a lot of people's budget. There has to be a better alternative.
